And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.


3. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

- Ascension

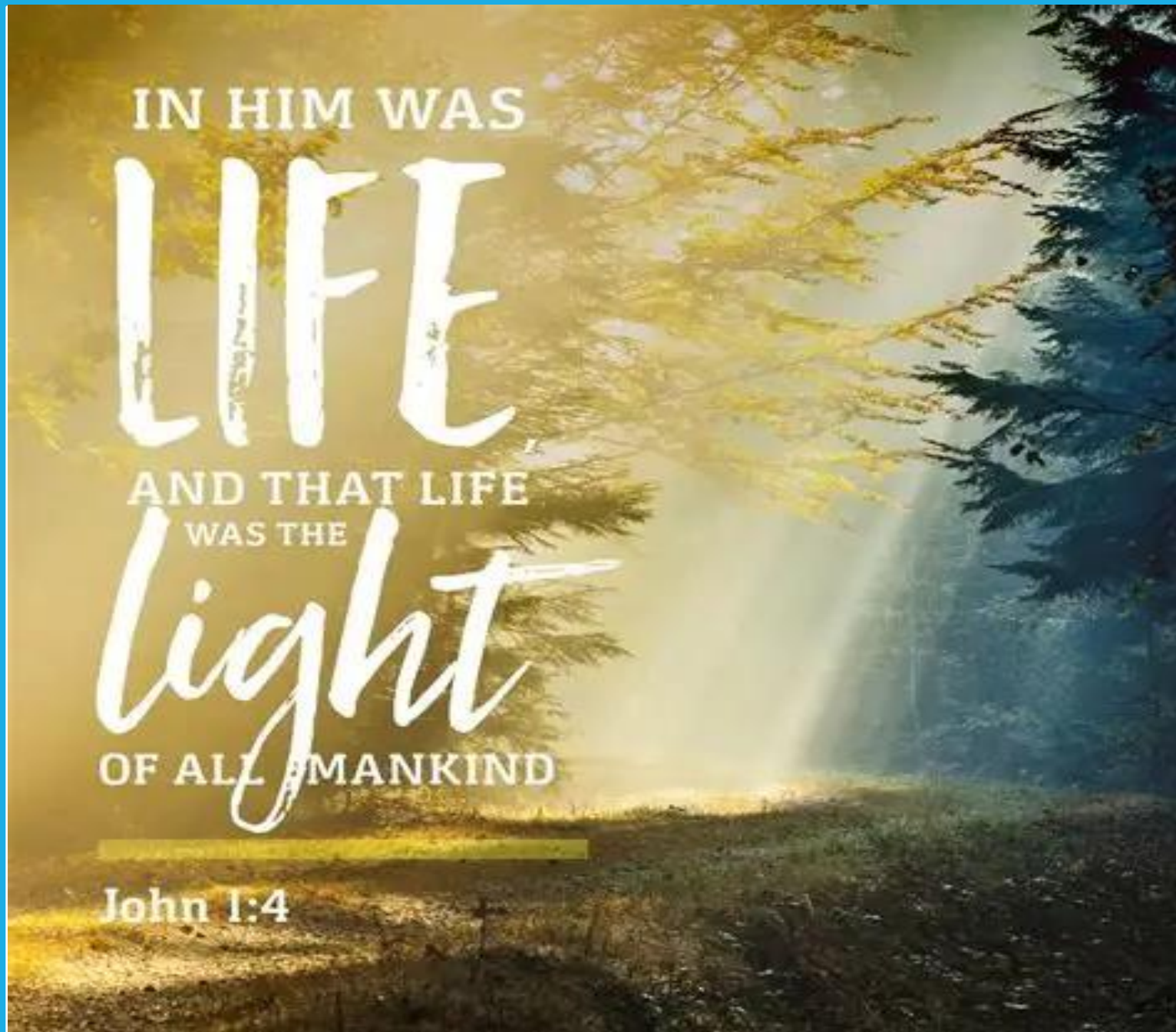
John shows us who Jesus is by.....
